DAY 1 – Thanksgiving

Time: 9:00AM-12:00PM

SCRIPTURAL TEXT: Psalm 136; Mark 11:24

- Thank God for the majesty of His creation and His providence for His whole creation.
- Thank God for the President: for the wisdom He has given him.
- Thank God for His protection, healing and deliverance.
- Thank God for His mercies, tender care and abundant love.

Time: 12:00PM-3:00PM

SCRIPTURAL TEXT: Psalm 66:18, Isaiah 55:7, Isaiah 59:1-2

- Confess the sins of the Church and the leadership of the Church in Ghana.
- Confess the sins of our families and ancestors

Day 1- Healing and Deliverance

Time: 3:00PM-6:00PM

SCRIPTURAL TEXT: Deuteronomy 9:25-29, 1 Timothy 21:3

- For a mighty and miraculous deliverance from the COVID-19 Pandemic in Ghana and the nations of the world.
- For the healing of those who have been infected and undergoing treatment throughout the world.
- For frontline workers worldwide, that they will be divinely protected from being infected.
- For the leadership of the nation and the arms of Government.

Scriptural Text: 1 Samuel 7:5; Psalm 32:8; 147:14; Jeremiah 29:7; Ezekiel 22:30

Prayer Points

- For unity, peace and stability of the nation.
- For the nations and the Church to learn the needed lessons (spiritual, social, economic, cultural etc) from the pandemic
- For the Church, that this may serve as turning point in the future of the Church in Ghana, that this bond of unity may become stronger by the day.
- For the plans of to be established in the nations of the world.
- For leaders to take the right decisions during this time of crisis.
- For prosperity and economic recovery.

Day Three (3)

Friday March 5, 2021

Theme: Thanksgiving
